Bible Exposition Self-Training Program focuses on skills of Bible study, bible exposition and preparation of bible study guides. The group is initially trained on inductive Bible Study, principles of bible interpretation and the art of sermon preparation and presentation.

4. Our distinctives

An Evangelical Movement - ZAFES is committed to proclamation of the gospel of Christ and to a biblical faith as summarized in the doctrinal basis of faith. ZAFES activities are open to everyone. But a personal faith in Christ and an agreement with the basis of Faith are essential for membership.

An Interdenominational Movement -ZAFES brings together students from different denominations that subscribe to the ZAFES doctrinal basis of faith and Constitution. In ZAFES we believe that unity is crucial to effective campus witness. We recognize and respect sectarian issues that divide us but have agreed to disagree on such issues because unity is crucial to the extending of the kingdom of God through preaching the gospel of Christ.

Church Based -ZAFES is not a church but a specialized ministry to students of post- secondary education institutes. Therefore, ZAFES restricts CFs from functioning like a Church and independent of the church. All ZAFES members, however, are strongly encouraged to be members of a local church to which they should be accountable.

A Student Initiated/Staff Guided Movement In ZAFES, we believe that students are best placed to share the gospel with their fellow students with whom they interact with in various ways. Student initiative in organizing and planning their own CF activities is a key element in our student leadership development process. ZAFES staff is available to advise, train and students to ensure they run CFs in keeping with the movement's aims and doctrinal basis of faith.
